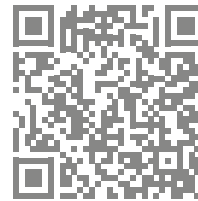

**MCA Primary Level** is the ideal continuation after Noah's Ark Kindergarten and is also well suited for children from other domestic and foreign educational institutions. We accompany students from Pre-school to 4<sup>th</sup> grade – newcomers are welcome at any time! As a state-recognized private school of the Free Churches in Austria (freikirchen.at) with public law status, we offer a solid academic foundation. The basis is the **Austrian elementary school curriculum**, which we expand with special emphases:

**Christian education, intensive English lessons, lively project-based learning, methodological competence, and active student participation.**

We are convinced that Christian-based education makes children strong – in learning, in life, and in faith. We enthusiastically accompany them as they discover and develop their talents and experience the world as God's great gift.

## **Multi-level Classes (MSK)**

From pre-school to 4<sup>th</sup> grade, usually five children per year learn together, accompanied

by two teachers, in mixed-age groups. This form of learning creates valuable experiences, especially since many children today grow up without siblings. The advantages:

- Students with learning difficulties experience success when they help younger children.
- Strengthening independence and personal responsibility

- Playful, sensory, and practical learning

This creates a lively, holistic learning environment that combines knowledge, social skills, and the joy of discovery.

## **Language Support and German as a Second Language (DaZ)**

No matter what their language skills are, every child will find the right start with us. Individual support in small groups is provided by our experienced team in German and English. Other languages can be offered as optional exercises.

## Step 3: Pay Fees

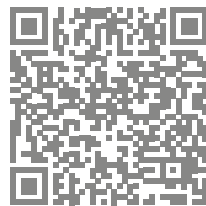
Pay the registration fee, deposit, and gym shirt.

# School Registration Process

## Step 1: Initial Contact

Register via our website for an appointment for an open house or an individual appointment (using the online form).

## Step 2: Open House

Get an impression of our school at an open house in October, November, January, or May.

## Step 3: Pre-registration

Fill out the corresponding online form (which will be sent to you by the school office) and upload ALL required documents. Pay the pre-registration fee (which will be credited toward the final registration fee). Then make an appointment for the next step.

## Step 4: Getting to Know Each Other

Your child will get an impression of our school and we can get to know them during an appointment for the school readiness test (first graders) or a "taster day" (school transfer). After an internal evaluation process, we will invite you to a final meeting with our school management to discuss the decision on admission with you.

## Step 5: School Registration

Fill out the appropriate online form (will be sent to you by the school office). Upload ALL required documents. Pay the registration fees specified in the form.
