

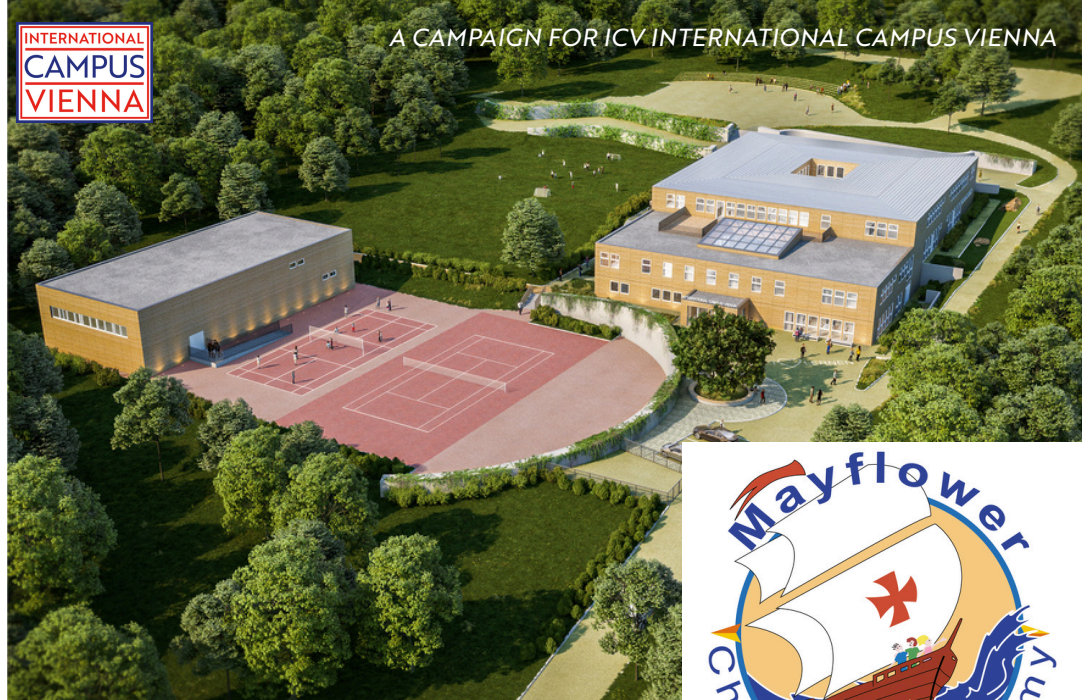

## Because Education Matters

**International Campus Vienna** (ICV) is where learning comes alive—a place where children don't just prepare for tests, but for life itself. Nestled in Vienna's green Oberlaa district, ICV brings together **Kindergarten Arche Noah** and **Mayflower Christian Academy** on a single, purpose-built campus. For nearly 30 years, these institutions have shaped young lives with excellence and care. Since 2019, they've united under one roof to offer families something truly distinctive: a seamless educational journey from ages 1 to 14.

## A Community Without Borders

Our campus is home to children from over 30 nations and families from diverse social, economic, and faith backgrounds. This vibrant international community shares a common commitment: raising children who are academically capable, spiritually grounded, and socially conscious.

At ICV, Christian values aren't just taught—they're lived. Faith shapes daily life on campus, building character, resilience, and responsibility. Yet our doors are open wide. We welcome families of all backgrounds who seek an education that nurtures the whole child.

# ABOUT US

## The current financial challenge

Independent Christian education in Europe faces increasing pressure. Rising operational and infrastructure costs, limited public funding structures, and the need to balance educational excellence with affordability create a challenging environment.

First: During the COVID-19 pandemic, parts of the campus were temporarily closed, leading to reduced income from kindergarten and school fees. As a result monthly renting costs have been deferred.

Second: The current annual financial situation reflects operational strength. Since 2024, both the kindergarten and the school at our new campus, operate with balanced, sustainable annual budgets.

**The current challenge lies solely in addressing historic, deferred rental obligations.**

**ICV operates with disciplined financial governance and avoids crisis-driven fundraising.** Nevertheless even with this important attempt to close the financial gap due to deferred rental cost we want and need to **ensure access to Christian Education for all children, including those with special needs** through partnerships with sponsors and donors.

## Our Networks

The International Campus Vienna is embedded in **strong national and international education networks**, including partnerships with Pacific Hills Christian School (**Sydney**), VEBS (**Germany**), EACE at **EU level**, and the global **ACSI network**.

Since 2025, **Erasmus+ accreditation** has further enabled student and teacher exchange across Europe.

These connections support quality, accountability, and advocacy for Christian education in Europe and beyond.

## Outreach, Social Impact & KILI Project

Social responsibility is an integral part of campus life.

Our community actively supports:

- initiatives such as **Mary's Meals** (through second-hand uniform fundraising), **refugee children** at our campus, **Operation Christmas Child**, and **JAM Africa**, providing daily meals for 400 children in Johannesburg. We also support **single mothers locally**, assist **new Christian schools in Austria** through expertise, host **Pastors' Breakfasts to strengthen leadership in Christian education**, and regularly engage with **elderly residents** nearby.
- KILI is a current focus project. Since September 2025, ICV **has welcomed children with special needs**, with public funding covering only part of the additional costs.

**ICV serves both the Christian community and the wider society, offering high quality education grounded in faith while remaining accessible and supportive for children with special needs.**
