Meeting the Moment: Our Financial Reality and Vision Forward

Christian education in Europe today requires both courage and partnership. Rising costs, limited public funding, and our commitment to keeping tuition accessible create real financial pressures—but also opportunities for faithful supporters to make lasting impact.

The Challenge We Face

Like many institutions, we faced significant disruption during the COVID-19 pandemic. Temporary campus closures reduced our kindergarten and school enrollment, creating a gap in revenue that led to deferred rental obligations. While we've maintained our educational mission without compromise, these accumulated costs now require attention.

Our Strength Today

Since moving to our new campus in 2019, both our kindergarten and school operate with balanced, sustainable annual budgets. Our programs are thriving, our enrollment is strong, and our financial governance is disciplined.

The challenge before us is singular and solvable: addressing the historic rental obligations deferred during the pandemic.
