For years, it has been our heartfelt desire to be able to offer children with special needs a **high-quality kindergarten and, subsequently, school place** at our International Campus Vienna. Now, the time has finally come!

Why does our KILI-Project matter

- In Vienna, **1.500 children with disabilities** are currently waiting for a suitable spot in an inclusive kindergarten. Their parents are often left alone to deal with the special care requirements, which is why they need our support.
- **Equal opportunities** for children with special needs: Here at ICV, we are convinced that God created every child to be unique and wonderful. Therefore, all children should receive the best possible education, regardless of their physical or mental abilities.
- **We have a societal duty to provide ALL children-** with and without disabilities- with the best opportunities for development in a loving, inclusive environment.
- We want to offer parents a **reliable, long-term spot in an inclusive kindergarten!** This requires secure funding for at least 4 years, so that we can plan accordingly for the long run.

 My name is Kilian, I am almost 2 years old and I am diagnosed with Down-Syndrom. This means I need extra time to complete certain developmental steps. That doesn't matter so much **in our Noah's Ark kindergarten** because, **here, I am allowed to be myself.** Every morning, I arrive at the Campus with a big smile on my face. The other children play with me, we laugh, build towers, and even sing together. Our **special education teacher, Marta**, is super friendly!

She shows me and my friend how to make small steps which feel like a big success for us. **We would love to have more kids, who don't quite fit the norm, be supported and cared for by Marta and other amazing people here on campus!**
