## Insights into ...

## **Primary School:**

Well rested and relaxed after the autumn break, the primary school started into November.

The English class of Ms. Anna worked on the topics "rooms in a house" and "furniture". The children had a lot of fun working on this topic. They worked very diligently in single, partner or group work. The class dealt with objects that belong either in the bathroom, in the kitchen, in the bedroom or in the living room. The children are able to identify certain furniture that could only be found in one room, but also discussed, for example, whether a table belongs in the kitchen or in the living room.

In future lessons, the students will deal with different places, for example the park, the school, the playground, at home with friends and more. In this context, the students should be able to describe and explain different ways and places.

## **Secondary School:**

French and its vexed pronunciation:

French becomes serious from the 7th grade onwards - a real, even assessed, school subject. Whereas in the first two school years of the SEK it was only about cultural topics and simple, playfully acquired vocabulary, now real exercises are added. The children already have English as a learning language, but now, they come into contact with French, which is so very different - and are often overwhelmed because it is so different from German or English. That's why we start the school year with pronunciation games, where the kids can overcome their fear a bit. In November, this pronunciation is then tried out with a first presentation in which certain things are to be said in French. Of course, we continue to work on this, bit by bit and playfully, which is always fun for our 7th graders.
